Caution:

§ 55 para. 1 in conjunction with § 55 para. 2 of the German Residence Act stipulates that a foreigner can be expelled from Germany if he/she has supplied false or incomplete information in order to be granted a residence title (whether filing an application in Germany or in another signatory state to the Convention Implementing the Schengen Agreement). Applicants are obligated to provide the required information to the best of their knowledge and belief. If an applicant deliberately provides false or incomplete information, his/her application for a residence title may be rejected and, if a residence title has already been granted, the applicant may be expelled from Germany. By signing the application form, the applicant confirms that he/she was cautioned about the legal consequences of providing false or incomplete information when filing an application.

Data collection:

Pursuant to § 86 of the German Residence Act, the authorities responsible for the implementation of the Residence Act are empowered, for the purpose of implementing this law and the provisions relating to foreigners as laid down in other laws, to collect personal data to the extent that this is required to fulfil their duties under the Residence Act and under provisions relating to foreigners in other laws. It is legally permissible to collect data as defined in § 3 para. 9 of the German Federal Data Protection Act and in corresponding provisions of the data protection acts of the German Federal States, to the extent that this is necessary for the fulfilment of duties in individual cases.

I hereby affirm that the information I have provided above is correct and complete to the best of my knowledge and belief. False or incorrect information may result in the revocation of the EU Blue Card and may also lead to criminal proceedings.

I am aware of the fact that a fee is charged for the processing of the application for an EU Blue Card. The fee will not be reimbursed if the application is withdrawn or rejected.
